

Collective director arrested in Trinity

Some 1,170 marijuana plants were seized or destroyed by Trinity County drug agents in a raid last week.

On Aug. 19, the Trinity County Narcotics Task Force served a search warrant at a property at 13 Dips Road in Hayfork.

Agents arrested 35-year-old Jason Zacharia Tanner on the property, sheriff's spokeswoman Lynn Ward said Friday.

Tanner, the director of the Dakini Collective in Orange County, was the only member of the collective present at the grow site, Ward said.

The Dakini Collective has more 2,000 members, mostly from Southern California, Ward said.

"Tanner had no caregiver relationship with the 'patients' so he was ar-

rested, and the marijuana plants were eradicated and seized," Ward said.

Tanner was booked on suspicion of cultivating marijuana and conspiracy. He was released from jail the same day after posting \$30,000 bail, Ward said.
